

Peace Post Plan: We are partnering with St. James Presbyterian to tear out old divider posts between our two cemeteries and turn four of the old posts into peace posts. There will be many stages to this process, so check out the list below for how you can participate!



Work Day: Demolish Division

May 25 (Saturday) 9am-11am

Demolish all but four of the concrete post dividers that separate our two cemeteries.

Calling all people with muscle who can heft a sledgehammer or wield a grinder.

The four to save are marked with yellow ties. These will become the peace posts.

Create Day: Make Markers

May 30 (Thursday) 6pm-8pm

Make the pieces that will be the four sides for each peace post and base paint them.

Calling crafters, painters, people who can get their hands dirty and have fun doing it.

Art Day: Paint Post Pieces

June 2 (Sunday) 2pm-4pm

Draw out the background art for the posts and paint them according to the designs.

Calling artists, painters, designers who can paint an image from a rendering.

Lettering Day: Write the Words

June 13 (Tuesday or Thursday) 6pm-8pm

Stencil on the lettering and paint in the letters for each post.

Calling painters, artists, designers, detail-oriented types who can be extremely neat with paint.

Installation Day: Seal and Secure

July 6 (Saturday) 9am-11am

Attach painted post pieces to the post forms and secure them, then seal the edges.

Calling creative construction people, comfortable using liquid nail, clamps, and sealant.

Celebration Day: Partnering in Peace

July 14 (Sunday) TBA

Have a cookout or a picnic with a dedication ceremony to bless the new posts and celebrate.

Calling everyone from both churches to come together for joy and food.
