# Invitation to the Lord's Supper

Our Lord invites all who trust in him, and all who long to trust in him,

God's table offers us a feast for our spiritual lives!

Here, we are joyfully reminded that God has our best interest at heart, that God is able to provide all we need, and that God delights in sharing strength through grace with us.

This table is where we come when we feel we aren't enough, when we fear we cannot persevere, and when we forget that God provides presence, purpose, and power.

At this table we do not pay the bill, for Christ has already settled it himself. We receive a meal of grace we cannot repay solely because of grace. Through God's mercy and love we are invited to overcome all that makes us weak by welcoming the mighty power of God into our lives. Ephesians 1:19 says that this is the "same mighty power that raised Christ from the dead and seated him in the place of honor at God's right hand in the heavenly realms." It is a mystery we ponder at this table. Through it we have communion with Jesus Christ as a family of faith.

Hear these words from Apostle Paul to the church of why we do this sacred act 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

For I received from the Lord what I also handed down to you,
that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took a loaf of bread,
and when he had given thanks, he broke it
"This is my body that is broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
In the same way he took the cup after supper saying,
"This cup is the new covenant in my blood." Do this as often as you drink it in remembrance of me.
For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup,
you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.
